


The first thing you should do is update your plans on Xello.

Next...visit PowerSchool to see what required courses are left to complete.

Check "Graduation Progress" button on PowerSchool now and after every semester. How many credits do I need to earn my diploma and participate in the graduation commencement ceremony at the end of my Senior year?



Credits: Are you on track to graduate with your class?

You should have at least 13.0 credits right now (2nd Sem, Junior Year)

At the end of this school year you should have at least 16.0 credits.





If I am short credits, what are my options for credit recovery?


- After school day, CVS Credit Recovery with Community Ed at Mohegan (\$\$)

When planning your course request, start with the required courses.

Senior year is your year to get ready for college and career.

Explore your interests and challenge yourself.

Every Senior must have a "math" course in their 12th grade year. Here are options within the Mathematics Department. Talk with your teacher for a recommendation.

Two credits of a single World Language is required.

Students who complete a CTE program or take an additional credit of Visual/Performing Arts & Applied Arts may waive the 2nd credit requirement. If you are a Band or Choir student, request the course your teacher recommends. If there are auditions for different course levels, those changes will be made at the end of this school year.

Space is limited in most of these programs. Preference given to students who can complete the program. Have an alternative plan ready.



Internships for credit are available to seniors who have previously completed two semesters in a related CTE program (usually in their sophomore or junior year) and are concurrently enrolled in a related CTE course in the senior year. There are several ways to earn College Credit while in high school:



- Advanced Placement (AP) Exams (Application due by April 1st).
- Articulation Agreements (talk to CTE teacher for details).
- **Dual Enrollment** (Mandatory meeting for interested students and parents on March 25, 2024 at 7pm in CVHS Auditorium)

AP Application Form required for each course and are available from CVHS Guidance and Counseling. Deadline to apply is April 1st! We ask that students commit to staying in AP courses all year! **No dropping!**

Make sure you list acceptable Alternative Selections at the bottom of your Course Request Form because you just might get that course.

In other words: Pick a good backup plan.



When will my high school schedule be available to view?

At Big Red Check In in August.

Your counselor may talk with you in June if there is a problem with your schedule that needs to be resolved.



Why is it so difficult to change my schedule after the school year starts?

- Teachers are assigned to the courses students request.
- High school schedules are like a big puzzle...changing course impacts another.
- That's why we can't honor special requests for teachers, lunches, etc.
